
ORIGINAL PLAN CONFIRMED DEUTERONOMY 28:12, 13 NKJV

JACOB'S STORY Genesis 29:13-14 NKJV

Then it came to pass, when Laban heard the report about Jacob his sister's son, that he ran to meet him, and embraced him and kissed him, and brought him to his house. So he told Laban all these things. And Laban said to him, "Surely you are my bone and my flesh." And he stayed with him for a month. Then Laban said to Jacob, "Because you are my relative, should you therefore serve me for nothing? Tell me, what should <u>your wages be</u>? "

Wages - a fixed, regular, predetermined payment not easily able to change. Profits – Gain, dividends, interest, surplus, excess.

JACOB'S STORY

GENESIS 29:18, 20, 29 NKJV NOW JACOB LOVED RACHEL; SO HE SAID, "I WILL SERVE YOU SEVEN YEARS FOR **RACHEL YOUR YOUNGER** DAUGHTER." SO JACOB SERVED SEVEN YEARS FOR **RACHEL, AND THEY SEEMED ONLY A FEW DAYS TO HIM BECAUSE OF THE LOVE HE** HAD FOR HER. THEN JACOB SAID TO LABAN, "GIVE ME **MY WIFE, FOR MY DAYS ARE** FULFILLED, THAT I MAY GO IN TO HER."

Jacob now enters the "System of Labor"

Remember Jacob comes from the ownership system where the father has great wealth and he serves his father and his father leaves him an inheritance.

Inheritance - Legacy, endowment, birthright, estate

Characteristic of the Labor System:

It does not love or care for you or have your best interest at heart. The Labor system cares for its wellbeing, its success, its stock holders, its prosperity.



The Labor System is set up to welcome you in and never let you out!



JACOB'S Story Genesis 29:25, 27

25 So it came to pass in the morning, that behold, it was Leah. And he said to Laban, "What is this you have done to me? Was it not for Rachel that I served you? Why then have you deceived me?"

27 Fulfill her week, and we will give you this one also for the service which you will serve with me still another seven years."


CHARACTERISTICS OF THE LABOR System

The Labor System enslaves you with minimum wages, bad debt, poor and incomplete education, target marketing and tainted research that convinces you to desire the trappings of wealth, offering you expensive merchandise that you don't need and don't want (Leah).



The great escape

Most slaves worked Monday - Saturday 15-16 hours/daily

Most slaves endured what was known as "Hard Driving". That's the phrase chosen to describe the the way the slave master would push the slave beyond normal physical abilities.

The work week was virtually never stopped by weather (hot, cold, rain, extreme heat or storm. Nothing was to stop Master from making his money. There was little care for the needs of the worker.

The work didn't slow if you were pregnant, or if you had an infant child that had to be nursed you would carry the child on your back while you worked 15-16 hour days.

Finally, for all of your labor you would be provided a place to stay (with up to 90 people living in one small quarters, scraps of food, meager clothing, and a carriage ride by the slave driver out to the field every morning.

THE GREAT ESCAPE

They were stuck building someone else's dreams, someone else's business.

And though they were brutally tired, and beatdown, they could actually hire themselves out to make money for themselves by working on another slave owner's plantation.

Brokering their own deals, they would pay their master a portion and keep the rest for themselves, they could make as much as \$100-\$500 yearly. In today's money that is like making \$3,000-\$15,000/extra per year.

Some used these earnings, this money that they earned for themselves to purchase their freedom.

You have been working hard for someone, but what if you turn those energies toward your own business.
